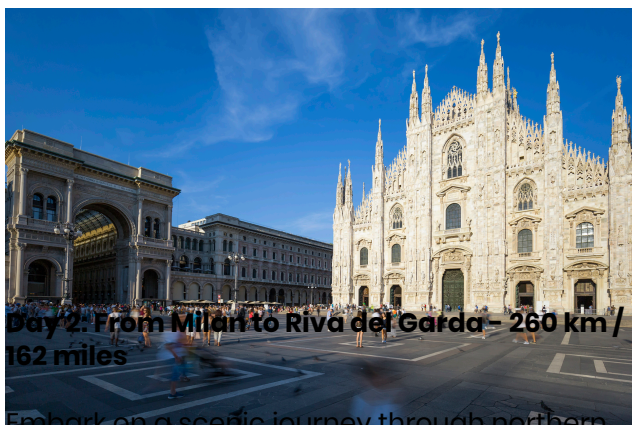

PROGRAM



Day 2: From Milan to Riva del Garda - 260 km / 162 miles

Embark on a scenic journey through northern Italy. Stop at Lago d'Iseo, a serene lake surrounded by picturesque villages, and drive through Passo Presolana, offering stunning alpine views. Continue to Croce Domini, a mountain pass with breathtaking panoramas, before reaching the tranquil Lago di Ledro near Riva del Garda, your destination by the beautiful Lake Garda.

Highlights: lago d'Iseo, passo Presolana, Croce

Day 1: Arrive in Milan

Welcome to Milan, the fashion and cultural capital of Italy! Spend your first day exploring iconic landmarks like the Duomo di Milano, Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, and Sforza Castle. Enjoy the city's vibrant atmosphere and savor a delicious meal at a local trattoria.

Day 3: From Riva del Garda to Venezia - 253 km / 158 miles

Begin the day driving through the charming Col di Castion and ascend Passo Fugazze, where the scenery transforms into rolling hills and vineyards. Marvel at the natural beauty of the Colli Euganei, a volcanic hill region, before arriving at the enchanting Baia di Chioggia, a peaceful lagoon area on the way to Venice. Spend the evening in the magical canals of Venezia.

Highlights along the way: Col di Castion, passo Fugazze, colli Euganei, baia di Chioggia

Day 4: From Venezia to Mantova - 254 km / 159 miles

Head south along the Strada dei Murazzi, a coastal route offering views of the Venetian Lagoon. Discover the unique landscapes of the Delta dell'Adige, where the river meets the Adriatic Sea. Follow the Argine del Po, a riverbank route along the mighty Po, to reach Mantova, a UNESCO World Heritage city known for its Renaissance architecture and serene lakes.

Highlights: strada dei Murazzi, delta dell'Adige, argine del Po



Day 5: From Mantova to Portovenere - 234 km / 146 miles

Continue along the scenic Argine del Po before climbing the Passo della Cisa, a mountain pass connecting Emilia-Romagna to Tuscany. Arrive at Portovenere, a charming coastal town near Cinque Terre. Explore its colorful waterfront, medieval castle, and the breathtaking views of the Ligurian Sea.

Highlights: argine del Po, passo della Cisa





Day 6: From Portovenere to Firenze - 243 km / 151 miles

Travel along Il Golfo di La Spezia, also known as the Gulf of Poets, and pass through the stylish Riviera di Viareggio. Drive through the Parco Regionale Alpi Apuane and the rugged beauty of the Parco Regionale dell'Alto Appennino Modenese, with a stop at Abetone, a mountain town. Conclude the day in Florence, the cradle of the Renaissance.

Day 8: From Firenze to Siena - 212 km / 132 miles

Drive through the lush Foresta di **Vallombrosa**, a peaceful forest near Florence. Pass through the renowned Chianti wine region, where rolling vineyards and quaint villages await. Visit the medieval towers of San Gimignano and the hilltop town of Volterra, known for its Etruscan heritage, before arriving in Siena.

Highlights: Foresta di Vallombrosa, Chianti, San Gimignano, Volterra



Day 10: From Assisi to Rome - 225 km / 140 miles

Descend through the lush Valnerina, known for its verdant valleys and medieval villages. Pause at the spectacular Cascata delle Marmore, a man-made waterfall of remarkable beauty. Continue along the historic SS3, also known as Via Flaminia, and arrive in Rome, the Eternal City, ready to immerse yourself in its history and grandeur.

Highlights: Valnerina, cascata delle Marmore, ss3

Day 7: Firenze and Pisa Loop - 184 km / 115 miles

Set out to explore the Tuscan gems of Lucca, a walled city with charming cobblestone streets. Visit Piazza dei Miracoli in Pisa, home to the iconic Leaning Tower. End the loop in Livorno, a vibrant port city with stunning sea views, before returning to Florence for the evening.

Highlights: Lucca, Piazza dei Miracoli, Livorno



Day 9: From Siena to Assisi - 242 km / 152 miles

Travel through the striking clay hills of Le Crete Senesi, stopping in Asciano for its historic charm. Explore the Renaissance town of Pienza and the picturesque streets of Città della Pieve. Follow the scenic routes SS71, SS79, and SS317, soaking in the Umbrian countryside, before reaching Assisi, the birthplace of St. Francis.

Highlights: le Crete Senesi, Asciano, Pienza, Città della Pieve, ss71, ss79, ss317

Spend your final moments in Rome, visiting iconic landmarks like the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Vatican City. Enjoy a leisurely morning before departing for your flight, carrying unforgettable memories of your Italian adventure.

- Up to 60 days before the start date, the advanced payment is kept for the entire following season as credit towards a tour or a rental.
- From the 59th day to the 15th day before the start date, you lose the advanced payment. The balance is kept for the entire following season towards a tour or a rental.
- From the 15th day before the start date, you lose the 50% of the total amount. The other 50% is kept for the entire following season towards a tour or a rental.
